PhD structure at FEM SUA

The PhD program at FEM SUA spans three years (full-time) or four years (external) and consists of 180 credits: 60 for coursework and 120 for research.

From the first year, students focus on independent research while completing compulsory coursework and participating in seminars, conferences, and workshops.

PhD students are also required to engage in teaching activities, such as lecturing, grading, or supervising students. The program culminates in a public defense of the dissertation, after which the title "PhD" is awarded for conducting original research and presenting it effectively.

Credits Breakdown

60 for coursework, 120 for research.

Teaching Requirement

Involvement in teaching, grading, or student supervision is mandatory.



University education in Slovakia, including the FEM PhD Programme, is free of charge for PhD. students studying in Slovak language at a present form.


- Part time students studying in English language pay € 2500 for academic year.
